URANUS/PLUTO ENERGY

“The only thing that doesn’t change is change itself.” The Grand Canyon was not always a grand canyon. Over thousands of years the water gradually creates the chasm of beauty. I think what is difficult for us now is the speed and intensity of change. When we look back and see all the amazing developments just since the beginning of the 20th century we wonder what could be in store for us now, in our recent future. At a time when our world is out of balance, viewpoints are polarized to the extreme, and the middle class is diminishing, what is going to break the deadlock, the impasse, the tension of the opposites? Carl Jung, the Swiss psychiatrist who brought us the most elevated system of psychology to date, called this condition “enantiodromia” a word he made up to describe the inner tension of a person who is one-sided, monolithic in his personality. The word literally means a “running to the opposites” and indicates for example, a person who is adamantly and vocally anti-gay but comes to realize that he, himself, is gay. We’ve actually seen this recently in the news with fanatical religious figures who have been exposed to themselves and their congregations.

“How low can you go” is a well known tai-chi expression. And “it takes 2 low notes to get 1 high note” is understood in opera singing. How low must we go before we begin our ascent to a

SUMMER CALENDAR

The planetary configurations are really interesting these days. We've just had an Eclipse of the Sun that was visible in the U.S. Eclipses are more potent in the places where they are visible.

In addition there was a rare Venus conjunct the Sun. This is not an unusual occurrence as Venus' orbit is only 88 days. What made the conjunction rare is that Venus transited right across the Sun. Since the planes of the Earth and Venus are different, this appears only every 120+ years when the orbital planes of the two planets coincide. Venus and Jupiter were conjunct at 11 degrees Taurus in March. They were the 2 brightest stars in the sky and were so beautiful being visible at early evening. I hope you got a chance to see them!

With so much Venusian energy astronomically, there is a good chance that you will find more harmony in your life, especially if you have planets in Gemini. Venus is a very personal planet and affects individuals more than nations unless there is a direct hit to a particular country or there is a very strong Venus in the birth of a nation chart. Venus is retrograde now and is passing around behind the Sun. She will turn apparently direct on June 28 at 7 degrees Gemini. She will then appear as a morning star. In ancient times, Venus was thought to be two stars: a morning star and an evening star. Now we know better!

Now as we enter the Summer Solstice on June 20th, we note that Jupiter has left its sojourn through Taurus and has entered Gemini. This new energy is airy, while Taurus was earthy and practical, so we will see more of a social movement from the planet that brings expansion and confidence. Jupiter in Gemini could bring us a more diverse dialog amongst the religious right, or a superficiality during the election process. It might even help the fractious Congress to take an interest in resolving the financial problems since Jupiter in Gemini wants financial security.

As of June 8 we are now on the 3 year trip with Pluto and Uranus squaring each other. These

two planets bring unexpected and radical change and where they connect in your chart will give you clues as to how you will be discovering new aspects of yourself. The greater resistance to change, the greater the discomfort from these two energies.

Saturn is also changing directions this month. On June 25, Saturn goes direct at 22 degrees libra and will move into Scorpio in early October. Astrologically this could help business especially in terms of making practical decisions. Also, hopefully, mature decisions from the Supreme Court.

Neptune turned retrograde on June 5th. Neptune is in its own sign of Pisces. The down side of this is the easy tendency toward fantasy and spin. You can easily see this in the lies that the various candidates make. The good part of Neptune being at home, is the creativity it engenders. Also spirituality can become more accessible. This is not to be confused with religiosity which is ruled by Jupiter. Neptune energy is defuse, borderless, ephemeral whereas Jupiter energy is well defined, known, legal. If you have Neptune well placed in your chart you might find yourself doing more yoga, meditation, watching movies or T.V. movies.

Uranus started a new cycle when it went into Aries the first sign of the zodiac. This strengthens the likelihood of bringing change. Uranus is making a station and will retrograde on July 13 encouraging a good look at our radical ideas.

Pluto is retrograde in Capricorn and will go back to 6 degrees 57 seconds on September 18 at which time it turns direct again. Pluto is especially harsh in Capricorn. But like all planets, it too has a good side, being able to successfully accomplish new ideas. It loves power and recognition in this constellation and is willing to unceasingly work to obtain its goals.

more compassionate, co-existent culture? Astrology gives us some clues. In a world of such tension, astrology gives us a sense of order and meaning to the world. This kind of astrology is called Mundane Astrology and is probably the first use of the foretelling of the stars in ancient times. It indicates what is happening in the world, thus the word, 'mundane.' The original astrologers were advisors to the kings and rulers of old.

As I write this we have just entered a 3-year period of tension between the outer planets, Uranus and Pluto. (An outer planet is so called because it cannot be seen with the naked eye, thus its energy tends to have a more universal or mundane effect.) What are the meanings of these two archetypes or symbols of consciousness?

Uranus is the first non-visible planet and indicates change. But it's sudden change, revolutionary and unexpected. It involves things that can't be seen: sudden insights, technology, things that come through the air: radio and t.v. waves. Uranus recently moved into the constellation of Aries where its energy is even more intense and more polarized: fanatical fighting for ideas, blind zeal, outbursts of energy, quick awareness, ambitiousness. Aries is the first sign of the zodiac, the pioneer, the me-first energy, the manager, the doer, but not the finisher.

Pluto in the last archetype (the symbol is more important than the name given it) in the solar system. This energy expresses itself in force and power. Those of you who have had a reading from me, know I call Pluto the "fascist." And for good reason! There isn't much we can do to resist Pluto's expression except by agreeing to it. Read the quote from Joseph Campbell on page 1. When Pluto makes itself known, transformation is inevitable. My Teacher, Adano Ley paraphrased a well known quote, "Yours in not to reason why, yours is but to do and live!" Agree to it! Pluto

symbolizes the collective unconscious, politicians, death (the ultimate transformation), regeneration, propaganda and sex. Why sex? Because of the "petit mort," orgasm. Pluto is currently in the constellation of Capricorn. This energy reveals a concentrated, serious, patient aim to life, vocation and industry. It's old age, a struggle for existence. The two energies together are formidable and can bring the successful outcome of new ideas, recognition, dictatorship. A lot of this we are seeing already in various parts of the world. But how will Pluto in Capricorn and Uranus in Aries square off?

We can get some clues by looking at the conjunction of these two planets that occurred in the mid 60's. Remember then? The "love generation," Haight-Ashbury hippies, but above all, the computer age began! There's big nostalgia for that time now, i.e. T.V's. "Mad Men," retro fashion. But currently there is a big burst of energy relating to electronics and computers: Siri talks, drones are being made and used by the private sector, privacy is an issue. And we have Augmented Reality glasses!

Another clue comes from the placement of Pluto in the U.S. Chart: the 11th, which in mundane astrology rules the Congress. Squaring Uranus in the U.S. money house it is indicative of the polarized Congress not able to make agreements about the financial situation, bank regulation and the national debt.

In the Ingress Chart there are more clues. Jupiter and Venus are in the 5th house, which rules the Senate which hopefully will foretell that the Senate will be beneficial; Mars and Neptune opposed in the 9th and 3rd houses indicate lies, spin, rumors in the media and newspapers and that people don't want to make the sacrifices to overcome the difficulties. Mostly it appears to be another year of excesses in promises, expenditures and wishful thinking. Since the Pluto/Uranus square lasts until mid 2014 there is ample time to assess what conditions it will bring to the world.

Do Some Research!

In the last quarter we had two significant planetary configurations: visible in the United States there was a 'ring-of-fire' eclipse at 0 degrees Gemini, and a couple of weeks later there was a rare eclipse of Venus at 15 degrees Gemini. If the eclipse made a contact with a planet in your own chart, the effects can last as much as 4 to 5 years. The effects of the Venus conjunct can last even longer!

Eclipses are not bad in themselves, but rather their effect depends on what they relate to in your own chart. For instance, the eclipse in Mitt Romney's chart conjoined his Ascendant! (Incidentally, Obama's Saturn conjoins his IC in January, indicating a move. These 2 energies would seem to say that Romney will be our next President.)

If the Venus conjunct is prominent in your chart it will probably bring unresolved past emotional experiences to the forefront, either by a meeting, or a remembrance. It can bring resolution and understanding to past relationships. When Venus was totally contained within the sphere of the Sun very positive energy was emitted, but basically a retrograde Venus under the Sunbeams is difficult.
